



HOW TO MAKE COMPOST LASAGNE

Compost is great for your garden.

Making your own compost helps the environment too!

Use this simple method to make compost. You can make it in a compost bin or lay it directly on a garden bed. It can take a while but it is very easy.

Make sure each layer is very wet before you add the next layer. Try to make the lasagne in one go so it doesn't dry out.

Put down a layer of newspaper or cardboard

Add a 2cm layer of active ingredients

Add a 2cm layer of dead ingredients

Keep layering layers until your lasagna is about 10 cms deep

Add a final 4cm deep layer of dead ingredients

Leave for 3-6 months

Active ingredients = rotted manure (e.g. chicken or cow poo – don't use pet poo!), green leaves or grass clippings, vegetable scraps, coffee grounds

Dead ingredients = dry leaves, straw, newspapers/cardboard
